

Mobile Van Request

Thank you for your interest in having an Enchanted Backpack Mobile Van visit your school or organization. Please review the criteria below to ensure your school/organization qualifies for support from Enchanted Backpack and that your school/organization can fulfill the Enchanted Backpack guidelines. Criteria:

Schools/organizations may request a Mobile Van visit if the following two requirements are met:

- A minimum of 50% of students qualify for the free or reduced lunch program or an equivalent "in need" federal or state program.
- Your school is an elementary or middle school or organization focused on serving children in the Chicagoland area.

The majority of vans will be sent to schools, but other organizations that work to better the future of underserved children can request an Enchanted Backpack van. Van requests will be granted based on time, availability and need.

Mobile vans deliver throughout the school year. We realize the need is great in schools that qualify for support, please be patient as we schedule deliveries.

Guidelines:

- Delivery date and time will be determined by the Enchanted Backpack team and coordinated with the school/organization. Enchanted Backpack reserves the right to reschedule deliveries in the event of inclement weather or other factors that may affect delivery.
- Each delivery site is required to provide a minimum of <u>eight adult volunteers</u> (ie: teachers, administrators, employees, parents) to assist in unloading the van.
- Teachers are highly valued by Enchanted Backpack! For that reason, a dedicated teacher-liaison from the school must be identified in the application. We promise not to take up too much of their time.
- Principal/administrator must sign a Delivery Receipt and Agreement. This includes an acknowledgment
 of product delivery with a list of donated goods and indicates that Enchanted Backpack materials are
 for the use of the students, teachers and school/organization.
- Distribution of the items in the school/organization is the responsibility of the Principal/Administrator.
- Feedback is a gift. Enchanted Backpack requires the principal/administrator and 10 teachers fill out a brief evaluation form within eight weeks of the delivery.
- When possible, schools/organizations will provide photos, videos and/or testimonials demonstrating the
 positive effect Enchanted Backpack has had on children and teachers. These may be used in Enchanted
 Backpack communication materials, on social media channels and website.
